Public Involvement Opportunities

- Review of PI materials and agency websites, listservs (use of and purpose of notifications).
- CD process – approach to PI meeting opportunity.
- Environmental justice issues, making sure Hanford is meeting legal requirements.

Public Involvement Opportunities (continued)

- Public involvement aspect brought into the technical committee presentations.
 - Determine if PIC should be involved further.
- More PIC member involvement directly on TPA activities.
- Standing agenda item for opportunities.

SOS Meeting Debrief

- Use mailed notifications of intent of meetings along with email notifications {Why does this matter to you?}.
 - Cost considerations
 - May be better use of funds than print ads
 - Print off copies and distribute in public places (e.g. colleges)
 - What's the open rate with certain subject headers/liners?

SOS Meeting Debrief (continued)

- Should meeting be more focused?
 - Hard to predict/do given current events may arise
 - Opportunity to increase public participation
- Need to review public comments/input given at meetings.
 - Follow up to questions asked
 - Some sort of meeting
- Need to review previous Board advice on doing annual SOS meetings.

100 F Public Meeting

- Difficulty hearing and need to identify who was speaking.
- Clear expectations of phone participants.

- GW – exposure scenarios – need to take public comment.
- Track comments coming in / or after the meeting.

100 F Advice

- The Board advises the agencies provide specific, additional information, notice, and take public comment on whether the maximum exposure scenario relied upon is truly the maximum exposure.
- Notification should include providing assumption of ICs for 150-200 years.
- [For upcoming River Corridor plans] add to advice bullet.
- Background: add comment in paragraph three.

100 F Advice (continued)

- Background – 3rd paragraph:
 - Public involvement materials didn't provide specific notice on reasonable maximum exposure scenarios.
- Advice:
 - Board advises notices for plans specify ICs, restrictions of resources, be made available for public to comment on.
 - Gerry to write background and advice bullet; present at Board meeting.
