

HAB Report Summary

- Tie reports and associated summaries to HAB Work Plan topics
- Compile reports and associated summaries on the HAB SharePoint site:
 - Provide the reports and a summary (a brief description)
 - Include a disclaimer on the SharePoint site. Note that:
 - the reports do not cover all topics
 - the reports are purely for information sharing
- Provide a one page summary of new available reports on the back table during Board meetings
- Provide TPA agency representatives with a courtesy review of report summaries

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Public Involvement Principles

- PIC members to look into past documents and references to see what information already exists. Potential sources may include:
 - Hanford Public Involvement Plan
 - Past advice/white papers on public involvement
- Review what public involvement strategies have been working well.
- Consider pros and cons on including public involvement points in technical advice:
 - Consider the complexity of the issue when providing advice
 - Greater topic complexity = more time and emphasis on public involvement

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HAB Member Sharing

- What issues are raised from sharing information with stakeholders & members of the public?
What are the interests that they share?
- Develop a vehicle to provide feedback
- Role of HAB member v. public citizens:
 - What is the distinction between the roles?
 - Is there a distinction between the roles?
- Board members to share information with other HAB members and TPA agency representatives on what they hear

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
