VI. ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

A. Chair and Vice Chair

1. The Chair shall be appointed by the sponsoring Tri-Party agencies, based on the advice and recommendations of Hanford stakeholders...

The term of office of the Chair will be for two years, with opportunity for reappointment for ~~no more than two~~ additional terms of two years each.

2. A Vice Chair will be selected by the Board to serve in the absence of the Chair.

The term of office of the Vice-Chair will be for two years, with the opportunity for reappointment for ~~no more than two~~ additional terms of two years each.

8. Board and Committee Leadership Structure

HAB Chair and Vice Chair

How long do they serve? ~~Is there a term limit?~~

The Board chair and vice chair positions are two-year terms with the opportunity to be selected for ~~two~~ additional two-year terms (~~three terms, or six years, in total~~).

HAB Committee Leadership

How long do committee leaders serve? ~~Is there a term limit?~~

The committee chair and vice chair are one-year positions, ~~with no term limits~~. Each position serves at the pleasure of the committee.

HAB National Liaison

What is the process for selecting a Board national liaison?

The national liaison position is a two-year term, ~~without term limits~~. The selection process occurs during the same timeframe as the selection process for the Board chair and vice chair:
