The Board is not prepared to provide a response to your comments. However, if you desire a response, the Chair will direct your views and comments to an appropriate party.

Finally, please note that if you need special accommodations, these can be arranged with the Board facilitator or the Board Chair.

In preparing to speak, the Board asks members of the public and of the Board to abide by the following guidelines:

1. Those wishing to offer public comment are asked to sign up at the registration table and will be invited to speak in the order listed on the sign-up sheet.
2. You will have an opportunity to provide comments during the public comment period designated on the agenda. Preference will be given to members of the general public over those individuals serving as members or alternates on the Board.
3. To insure all commentators have an opportunity to speak, speakers are asked to limit their remarks to five minutes. Depending on the number of speakers, the Chair may adjust the allotted time as needed. Groups that wish to present their views through a single spokesperson may be allowed additional time at the discretion of the Chair.
4. Commenters are asked to introduce themselves and their organizational affiliation, if any, at the beginning of their comments.
5. The Board cannot copy and distribute written comments. If prepared materials are provided, forty copies typically are needed to cover the Board membership.
