
Background

“To provide effective day-to-day oversight of contractor operations at DOE facilities so that line managers have accurate information on safe work performance. “

- May 28, 1992 – DNFSB Recommendation (92-2) for DOE to establish a formal program to select, train, and assign DOE Facility Representatives for the defense nuclear facilities.
- DOE-STD-1063-2006 – *Facility Representatives*
 - ...to ensure that competent DOE staff personnel are assigned to oversee the day-to-day contractor operations at DOE’s hazardous nuclear and non-nuclear facilities.
- RL Facility Representative Program Description
 - modeled after DOE-STD-1063-2006, *Facility Representatives*, and fully implements the provisions in the standard.




Richland Operations Office - Current Organizational Structure
