

What to do When the Snow Flies



Building Administrators and Facility Management Winter Preparation

- Purchase cold weather items (i.e., shovels, sand, and cold weather gear, if appropriate).
- De-icer materials, other than sand or rock salt, should be approved by your safety organization prior to use.
- Equip facilities with sand, shovels, brooms, and slip-resistant mats at building entrances.
- Know who to call for snow removal and de-icer material for walkways, parking lots, and roadways:
