A. The purpose of this modification is to authorize the contractor to complete specified actions prior to September 30, 2014 in support of the January 24, 2014 Ecology Agreed Order. The contractor is hereby provided an immediate Notice-to-Proceed (NTP) with an a Not-to-Exceed (NTE) authorized limit of \$1,000,000. Details of this contract change are included on page two of this modification.

B. Description of Change for Change Order 228:

SOW: Contract section C.2.3.14 Facility Management

The Contractor is directed to complete the following actions prior to September 30, 2014 in support of the January 24, 2014 Ecology Agreed Order:

1. Within 30-days from the effective date of the AO confirm the labeling on all waste packages being stored in the CWC Outside Storage Area A containing dangerous waste containers per the requirements specified in AO Section 1.11.1.1. Missing or obscured labels shall be corrected on the day they are discovered missing or damaged.
2. Cover or move inside a building all Retrievably Stored Waste (RSW) waste packages that are being stored in the CWC Outside Storage Area A. Currently, approximately 50 packages will require coverings or transfer to inside a building.
3. Interface with MSA on preparation of a draft Class 2 permit modification for making the Facility Contingency Plan and Hanford Emergency Management Plan applicable to SWOC units.
4. Provide notice to Ecology of any proposed or planned physical alterations/additions.
5. Prepare and submit to Ecology all Class 2 and Class 3 modifications to SWOC Units per the requirements of WAC 173-303-830 and AO Sections 1.12.4.1 and 1.12.4.2.
6. Complete training to sampling personnel within 60-days of the effective date of the AO.
7. Participate in a joint review with Ecology on the available information used to develop the process knowledge documentation associated with Retrievably Stored Waste (RSW) and identify a subset(s) of RSW boxes having sufficient knowledge to manage at PFNW. Establish a feedback loop in applying additional knowledge gained from the processing of RSW back to the originating process knowledge documentation.
8. Review and update procedures associated with spill notification to incorporate the new response thresholds, spill definitions and reporting criteria defined in the AO.
9. Review and update procedures associated with emergency response to include the requirements of the Hanford Emergency Management Plan (HEMP) and related contingency plan. Additionally, incorporate the new response thresholds, spill definitions and reporting criteria defined in the AO.
10. Support the drafting and submittal of a report to Ecology within 15 days of an incident triggering the RCRA contingency plan. Record all spills and/or releases of dangerous waste, mixed waste or hazardous substance in the appropriate

- SWOC Unit's spill log, including incidents that do not meet the notification criteria or reporting of the AO.
11. Train the appropriate SWOC facility personnel (including emergency coordinators) to the AO Section 1.2 reporting criteria within 60-days of the effective date of the AO. Provide additional training to these personnel within 14-days of issuance of the updated HEMP when issues. New personnel reporting to SWOC shall be trained to the AO reporting criteria and/or HEMP within 28 days of reporting to SWOC.
 12. Ensure that containers of dangerous waste at SWOC units be free of excessive dents and corrosion. For those containers that do not meet these AO requirements, they shall be repackaged or overpacked into compatible waste containers. To meet the objective of Section 1.9.5, purchase and deploy spill containment equipment at SWOC units for the loading and unloading of containers with known liquids in them.
 13. Within 30-days from the effective date of the AO, perform an inspection of waste containers and facility equipment at SWOC units per the requirements specified in AO Section 1.10.1. Remedy unsatisfactory conditions noted during the inspections per the requirements of AO Section 1.10.2, including timely repair of roof leaks. Perform and document those inspection and surveillances identified in AO Section 1.10.3.
 14. Initiate reviews and upgrades to the operating record system(s) for the SWOC units to enable timely availability of the records to Ecology per AO Section 1.13.2 and 1.13.3.
- C. The contractor is hereby provided an immediate notice-to-proceed (NTP) with a not-to-exceed (NTE) authorized limit of \$1,000,000 prior to the definitization of Change Order No. 228 in accordance with Contract Clause I.102. Do not exceed the NTE amount provided herein without prior approval from the Contracting Officer via a modification to increase this amount. Notify the Contracting Officer in writing with your rationale if the NTE amount is insufficient to proceed with the identified work.
- D. This modification does not add additional funds to the contract. Accordingly, work under the contract, such as that described herein, must be performed within the amount of funds which have been incrementally allotted to the contract in accordance with Clause I.81, "FAR 52.232-22 Limitation of Funds (Apr 1984)."
- E. The definitization schedule for this change order is as follows:
