
14. DESCRIPTION OF AMENDMENT/MODIFICATION (Organized by UCF section headings, including solicitation/contract subject matter where feasible.)

This modification definitizes the Fiscal Year 2009, 2010, and 2011 Cost Growth Proposals dated September 27, 2012 in the amount of \$\$615,165. The WBS elements and amounts are included as attachment 1

Table B.4-1 is updated as follows:

FY 2010 costs are increased by \$1,284,208 from \$328,476,198 to \$329,760,406. FY 2011 costs are decreased by \$(669,043) from \$314,570,776 to \$313,901,733. Total base period costs are increased by \$615,165 from \$1,583,499,864 to \$1,584,115,029. Total base period contract price is increased by \$615,165 from \$1,686,820,808 to \$1,687,435,973.
