FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST (FOI 2009-0054)

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that we have withdrawn our response dated September 14, 2009, and have issued the following determination regarding item 8 of your request.

In response to item 8, you requested “any records and documents relating to the contingency plan required pursuant to Washington Administrative Code Sections 173-303-806, 340, 350, 355 or 360, federal hazardous waste law (RCRA), or the federal Superfund law (CERCLA) and the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act of 1986, or any other legal requirement, for the mixed waste disposal trenches 31 and 34 located in the 200 West area of Hanford, and for the Low-Level Burial Grounds located in the 200 East and 200 West Areas of Hanford; including, but not limited to a) the contingency plan proposed when the facility was planned; b) the contingency plan effective when it was built and became operational; c) any contingency plan approved by the Washington Department of Ecology, and/or US EPA which is in effect today; d) any proposed contingency plans submitted to Ecology for revision of the Site-wide RCRA permit or for permitting of the Mixed Waste Trenches or the Low-Level Burial Grounds; and e) all correspondence from Washington Ecology or US EPA relating to deficiencies in any such application, seeking clarification of application elements, approving or rejecting any such applications.”

In response to item 8, a copy of DOE letter 08-AMCP-0063, dated December 19, 2007, has been deemed responsive to this item and was previously provided to you by this office on September 9, 2009. This document was also responsive to item no. 2 of your request. A letter dated November 6, 2008, from the State of Washington Department of Ecology regarding “United States Department of Energy Letter, dated October 9, 2008, Class 1 Modifications to the Hanford Facility Resource Conservation and Recovery Act Permit (Quarter Ending September 30, 2008)” and a copy of a U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) letter dated July 25, 1997, (DOE Letter 97-EAP-577) were also provided to you on August 5, 2009. Both documents are responsive to this item along with item 1 of your request. The attachment to DOE Letter 97-EAP-577 was document DOE/RL-88-20 Revision 1 entitled, “Hanford Facility Dangerous Waste Permit Application, Low-Level Burial Grounds.” This also was provided to you on August 5, 2009, and is responsive to this item.

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DOE Letters 95-PCA-294, 95-PCA-353, 96-EAP-343, Document HNF-5841, and a letter from the State of Washington Department of Ecology dated March 6, 1997, entitled, "Approval of Low-Level Burial Ground Part A, Revision 9" were previously provided to you on August 5, 2009, as Attachment V, and were also deemed responsive to this item along with items 6c, 6d and 6e of your request.

Enclosed is a copy DOE/RL-88-20, Revision 2 dated August 2008, see Attachment I. This contingency plan was provided to you on September 14, 2009, with deletions pursuant to Exemption 2. However, after a second review it is being provided in its entirety as the information was publicly released in a previous version, DOE/RL-88-20 Revision 1.

Lastly for this item, 510 documents have been located and are responsive. Enclosed as Attachment II is a listing of each document, along with the link to each document. We have also enclosed a CD so you would have all the links available to you electronically. These documents are publicly available on the Internet at:

In response to item 8a, you requested a copy of the contingency plan proposed when the facility was planned. A letter dated November 6, 2008, from the State of Washington Department of Ecology, and a copy of a U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) letter dated July 25, 1997, (DOE Letter 97-EAP-577) were provided to you on August 5, 2009. Both documents are responsive to this item along with item 1 of your request. The attachment to this letter (97-EAP-577) was document DOE/RL-88-20 Revision 1 entitled, "Hanford Facility Dangerous Waste Permit Applications, Low-Level Burial Grounds." This document was provided to you on August 5, 2009. Page 403 of this attachment included Appendix 7a, "Building Emergency Plan for Low-Level Burial Grounds." This was the proposed contingency plan.

In response to item 8b, you requested a copy of the contingency plan that was in effect when the facility was built and became operational. The contingency plan in effect when Trenches 31 and 34 became operational is the same contingency plan in effect when the facility was proposed. Therefore, see our response to item 8a. The following documents were also located: DOE Letters 95-PCA-294, 95-PCA-353, 96-EAP-343, Document HNF-5841, and a letter from the State of Washington Department of Ecology dated March 6, 1997, entitled, "Approval of Low-Level Burial Ground Part A, Revision 9." These documents were previously provided to you on August 5, 2009, as Attachment V, and were also deemed responsive to this item along with items 6c, 6d and 6e of your request.

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In response to item 8c, you requested any contingency plan approved by the State of Washington Department of Ecology or the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). The letter dated November 6, 2008, from the State of Washington Department of Ecology, and a copy of a U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) letter dated July 25, 1997, (DOE Letter 97-EAP-577) were previously provided to you on August 5, 2009. Both documents are responsive to this item along with item 1 of your request. The attachment to this letter was document DOE/RL-88-20 Revision 1 entitled, "Hanford Facility Dangerous Waste Permit Applications, Low-Level Burial Grounds." This also was provided to you on August 5, 2009. Page 403 of this attachment included Appendix 7a, "Building Emergency Plan for Low-Level Burial Grounds" and is the contingency plan.

In response to item 8d, you requested any proposed contingency plans submitted to the State of Washington Department of Ecology for revision of the Site-wide RCRA permit or for permitting of the Mixed Waste Trenches or the Low-Level Burial Grounds. Enclosed is a copy of Section 7.0 of DOE/RL-88-20, Revision 2 dated August 2008. This contingency plan was provided to you on September 14, 2009, with deletions pursuant to Exemption 2. However, after a second review it is being provided in its entirety as the information was publicly released in a previous version, DOE/RL-88-20 Revision 1.

In response to item 8e, you requested all correspondence from the State of Washington Department of Ecology or the EPA relating to deficiencies in any such application, seeking clarification of application elements, or approving or rejecting in such applications. 510 documents have been located and are responsive. Enclosed as Attachment II is a listing of each document, along with the link to each. We have also enclosed a CD so that you would have all the links available to you electronically. These documents are publicly available on the Internet at:

We have conducted a thorough search for documents responsive to your request. This search was conducted by those within the agency who are most familiar with the subject matter of your request, in locations where responsive documents would be found. Specifically we searched the files within the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) Environmental Management Division, Safety and Engineering Division, Waste Management Project and CH2M Hill Plateau Remediation Company (CHPRC).

A search was conducted of the Hanford Site Tri-Party Agreement Administrative Record and Public Information Repository, Low-Level Burial Grounds (LLBG) Operating Records located in the 200 West Area of the Hanford Site, CHPRC Waste and Fuels Management Project, CHPRC Environmental Projection, electronic data management systems, employee files and e-mails from the LLBG and the Engineering, Environmental Protection Office, Integrated Document Management System, Hanford Federal Facility Agreement and Consent Order Administrative Records, and LLBG Project Regulatory Files.

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The following key words were used to search for documents: Low Level Burial Grounds, LLBG, Mixed Waste Disposal Unit, MWDU, Mixed Waste Disposal Facility, MWDF, LBG Part A Permit Application, LLBG Part A, LLBG Part B Permit Application, LLBG Part B, LLBG PMM (Program Meeting Minutes), Meeting Minutes, Mixed Waste Disposal Trenches 31 and 34, Trenches 31 and 34, Trenches, Notice of Deficiencies, NOD, contingency, and contingency plan. Approximately 62,600 pages of documents were reviewed to determine if they were responsive to your request with approximately 188 hours of search time.

This is our final response to your request. The undersigned individual is responsible for this determination. You have the right to appeal to the Office of Hearings and Appeals, as provided in 10 CFR 1004.8, for the adequacy of our search. 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7.0 CONTINGENCY PLAN [G]

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The requirements for a contingency plan at the Low-Level Burial Grounds (LLBG) are satisfied in the following documents: Portions of the Hanford Facility RCRA Permit (Permit) Attachment 4 *Hanford Emergency Management Plan* (DOE/RL-94-02) and this Chapter.

The unit-specific building emergency plan also serves to satisfy a broad range of other requirements [e.g., Occupational Safety and Health Administration standards (29 CFR 1910), *Toxic Substances Control Act of 1976* (40 CFR 761), and U.S. Department of Energy Orders]. Therefore, revisions made to portions of this unit-specific building emergency plan that are not governed by the requirements of WAC 173-303 will not be considered as a modification subject to WAC 173-303-830 or Permit Condition I.C.3.

Table 7-1 identifies the sections of the unit-specific building emergency plan written to meet WAC 173-303-350(3) contingency plan requirements identified in this application. In addition, Section 12.0 of the unit-specific LLBG building emergency plan is written to meet WAC 173-303 requirements identifying where copies of Permit Attachment 4, *Hanford Emergency Management Plan* (DOE/RL-94-02) and the building emergency plan are located and maintained on the Hanford Facility. Therefore, revisions to Chapter 7.0 require a permit modification subject to WAC 173-303-830 and/or Permit Condition I.C.3.

6 **7.1 BUILDING EVACUATION ROUTING (BUILDING LAYOUT)**

7 Figures 7-1 and 7-2 provide identification of the primary and secondary staging areas and a general layout
8 of the LLBG. Alternate evacuation routes will be used on a case-by-case basis based on meteorological
9 conditions at the time of the event.

10 **7.2 BUILDING EMERGENCY DIRECTOR**

11 Emergency response will be directed by the Building Emergency Director (BED) until the Incident
12 Commander (IC) arrives. The incident command system (ICS) and staff, with supporting on-call
13 personnel, fulfill the responsibilities of the Emergency Coordinator as discussed in WAC 173-303-360.
14 During events, LLBG personnel perform response duties under the direction of the BED. The Incident
15 Command Post (ICP) is managed by either the senior Hanford Fire Department member present or senior
16 Hanford Patrol member present on the scene (security events only). These individuals are designated as
17 the IC and as such, have the authority to request and obtain any resources necessary for protecting people
18 and the environment.

19 The BED becomes a member of the ICP and functions under the direction of the IC. In this role, the BED
20 continues to manage and direct LLBG operations.

21 A listing of the BEDs by title, work location and work telephone number is contained in Section 7.7 of
22 this plan. The BED is on the premises or is available through an "on-call" list 24-hours-a-day.
23 Names and home telephone numbers of the BEDs are available from the Patrol Operations Center (POC)
24 in accordance with Permit Condition II.A.4.

25 **7.3 IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PLAN**

26 In accordance with WAC 173-303-360(2)(b), the BED ensures that trained personnel identify the
27 character, source, amount, and areal extent of the release, fire, or explosion to the extent possible.
28 Identification of waste can be made by activities that can include, but are not limited to, visual inspection
29 of involved containers, sampling activities in the field, reference to inventory records, or by consulting
30 with facility personnel. Samples of materials involved in an emergency might be taken by qualified
31 personnel and analyzed as appropriate. These activities must be performed with a sense of immediacy
32 and shall include available information.

33 The BED shall use the following guidelines to determine if an event has met the requirements of
34 WAC 173-303-360(2)(d):

35 1. The event involved an unplanned spill, release, fire, or explosion,

36 AND

37 2.a The unplanned spill or release involved a dangerous waste, or the material involved
38 became a dangerous waste as a result of the event (e.g., product that is not recoverable),

39 OR

AREA EVACUATION PROCEDURE	
	Evacuate personnel to the staging area; group personnel as follows: potentially contaminated protective clothing, keys immediately available for vehicles, those needing rides. Assist personnel that are temporary/permanently disabled.
	Conduct personnel accountability. If unable to account for personnel, report personnel accountability results to the Protective Actions Coordinator in the Hanford-Emergency Operations Center (Hanford-EOC) at any of the following numbers: 373-1786, 373-3876, 376-8612, or 376-4712.
	Inform IC of any potentially affected personnel (i.e., injured, contaminated, exposed, etc.) once the IC arrives at the ICP.
	Relay pertinent evacuation information (routes, destination etc.) to drivers.
	Dispatch vehicles as soon as the vehicles are loaded.
	Report status to the Hanford-EOC, request additional transportation if required, and report if any personnel remain who are performing late shutdown duties.

2 **Take Cover**

3 When the Take Cover Alarm is activated, personnel shall take cover in the nearest building or trailer.

4 A message followed by the Take Cover siren will be transmitted over the area emergency sirens.

5 Portable, hand-held radios are used throughout the LLBG for communication. The following actions
6 must be taken or considered:

7 • Shut doors and windows and wait for further instructions

8 • Secure ventilation system

9 • Follow normal exit procedures from radiological areas

10 • Lock up classified documents and prepare for a possible evacuation

11 • Report your location to the Accountability Aid or the BED

12 • Accountability Aides will provide accountability status to the Staging Area Manager for LLBG
13 personnel during an event

14 • Inform IC of any potentially affected personnel (i.e., injured, contaminated, exposed, etc.) once the IC
15 arrives at the ICP.

1 **7.3.2 Response To Facility Operations Emergencies**

2 Depending on the severity of the event, the BED reviews the site-wide and LLBG emergency response
3 procedure(s) and, as required, categorizes and/or classifies the event. If necessary, the BED initiates area
4 protective actions and Hanford Site Emergency Response Organization activation. The steps identified in
5 the following description of actions do not have to be performed in sequence because of the unanticipated
6 sequence of incident events.

7 **7.3.2.1 Loss of Utilities**

8 A case-by-case evaluation is required for each event to determine loss of utility impacts. When a BED
9 determines a loss of utility impact, actions are taken to ensure dangerous and/or mixed waste is being
10 properly managed, to the extent possible given event circumstances. As necessary, the BED will stop
11 operations and take appropriate actions until the utility is restored.

12 • Loss of Electricity. Electricity in the trailers is for lighting, heating, and cooling only. Loss of
13 electricity will not impair functions or constitute an emergency. Electrical power is required for
14 Trenches 31 and 34 of the 218-W-5 Burial Ground operations; however, loss of electricity does not
15 constitute an emergency, but must be restored as soon as possible. Electricity supplies power to the
16 sump pumps used to remove accumulated leachate from the primary and secondary liners. In the
17 event of a loss of electrical power and the leachate accumulation is in excess, a generator will be used
18 to provide temporary power.

19 • Loss of Water - N/A

20 • Loss of Ventilation - N/A

21 • Loss of Steam - N/A

22 • Loss of Air - N/A

23 **7.3.2.2 Major Process Disruption/Loss of Plant Control**

24 N/A

25 **7.3.2.3 Pressure Release**

26 N/A

27 **7.3.2.4 Fire and/or Explosion**

28 In the event of a fire, the discoverer activates a fire alarm (pull box); calls 911 (373-3800 if using a
29 cellular phone) or verifies that 911 has been called. The discoverer also notifies the Control Room
30 (PAX-222 or 376-0456).

31 • Unless otherwise instructed, personnel shall evacuate the area/building by the nearest safe exit and
32 proceed to the designated staging area for accountability.

33 • On actuation of the fire alarm, ONLY if time permits, personnel should shut down equipment, secure
34 waste, and lock up classified materials (or hand carry them out). The alarm automatically signals the
35 Hanford Fire Department.

- 1 • The BED proceeds directly to the ICP, obtains all necessary information pertaining to the incident
2 and sends a representative to meet Hanford Fire Department.
- 3 • The BED provides a formal turnover to the IC, when the IC arrives at the ICP.
- 4 • The BED informs the Hanford Site Emergency Response Organization as to the extent of the
5 emergency (including estimates of dangerous waste, mixed waste or radioactive material quantities
6 released to the environment).
- 7 • If operations are stopped in response to the fire, the BED ensures that systems are monitored for
8 leaks, pressure buildup, gas generation, and ruptures.
- 9 • Hanford Fire Department firefighters extinguish the fire as necessary.

10 **7.3.2.5 Hazardous Material, Dangerous and/or Mixed Waste Spill**

11 Spills can result from many sources including process leaks, container spills or leaks, damaged packages
12 or shipments, or personnel error. Spills of mixed waste are complicated by the need to deal with the extra
13 hazards posed by the presence of radioactive materials.

- 14 • The discoverer notifies the BED and initiates SWIMS response:
 - 15 – Stops work
 - 16 – Warns others in the vicinity
 - 17 – Isolates the area
 - 18 – Minimizes the spill if possible
 - 19 – Requests the BED Secure ventilation.
- 20 • The BED determines if emergency conditions exist requiring response from the Hanford Fire
21 Department based on classification of the spill and injured personnel, and evaluates the need to
22 perform additional protective actions.
- 23 • If the Hanford Fire Department resources are not needed, the spill is mitigated with resources
24 identified in Section 7.4 of this plan and proper notifications are made.
- 25 • If the Hanford Fire Department resources are needed, the BED calls 911 (373-3800 if using a cellular
26 phone).
- 27 • The BED sends a representative to meet the Hanford Fire Department.
- 28 • The BED provides a formal turnover to the IC when the IC arrives at the ICP.
- 29 • The BED informs the Hanford Site Emergency Response Organization as to the extent of the
30 emergency (including estimates of dangerous waste, mixed waste, or radioactive material quantities
31 released to the environment).
- 32 • If operations are stopped in response to the spill, the BED ensures that systems are monitored for
33 leaks, pressure buildup, gas generation, and ruptures.

- 1 • Hanford Fire Department stabilizes the spill.

2 **7.3.2.5.1 Damaged or Unacceptable Shipments**

3 During the course of receiving dangerous and/or mixed waste at LLBG, an unanticipated event could be
4 discovered resulting in a conformance issue concerning the waste. In some cases, the conformance issue
5 will result from receiving an off-site shipment, manifested pursuant to Permit, Condition II.P.1 or
6 WAC 173-303-370 that is damaged or otherwise presents a hazard and cannot be transported. Damaged
7 or unacceptable shipments resulting from onsite transfers are not subject to WAC 173-303-370; however
8 conformance issues must be resolved in order to maintain proper records.

9 Regardless of whether the waste is received as an off-site shipment or onsite transfer, the following
10 actions are taken.

- 11 • Operations management is notified of the damaged or unacceptable waste to be received.
- 12 • If the conformance issue results in a spill or release, actions described in Section 7.2.5 are taken.
- 13 • The generating organization is notified of the conformance issue.
- 14 • An operations representative, in conjunction with the generating organization, determines the course
15 of action to resolve the conformance issue.

16 **7.3.3 Prevention of Recurrence or Spread of Fires, Explosions, or Releases**

17 The BED, as part of the ICP, takes the steps necessary to ensure that a secondary release, fire, or
18 explosion does not occur. The BED will take measures, where applicable, to stop processes and
19 operations; collect and contain released wastes and remove or isolate containers. The BED shall also
20 monitor for leaks, pressure buildups, gas generation, or ruptures in valves, pipes, or other equipment,
21 whenever this is appropriate.

22 **7.3.4 Incident Recovery and Restart of Operations**

23 A recovery plan is developed when necessary in accordance with Permit Attachment 4, *Hanford*
24 *Emergency Management Plan* (DOE/RL-94-02), Section 9.2. A recovery plan is needed following an
25 event where further risk could be introduced to personnel, the LLBG, or the environment through
26 recovery action and/or to maximize the preservation of evidence.

27 If this plan was implemented according to Section 7.3 of this plan, Ecology must be notified before
28 operations can resume. Permit Attachment 4, *Hanford Emergency Management Plan* (DOE/RL-94-02),
29 Section 5.1 discusses different reports to outside agencies. This notification is in addition to those
30 required reports and must include the following statements:

- 31 • There are no incompatibility issues with the waste and released materials from the incident.
- 32 • All the equipment has been cleaned, fit for its intended use, and placed back into service.

33 The notification required by WAC 173-303-360(2)(j) may be made via telephone conference. Additional
34 information that Ecology requests regarding these restart conditions will be included in the required
35 15-day report identified in Section 7.5 of this plan.

36 For emergencies not involving activation of the Hanford-EOC, the BED ensures that conditions are
37 restored to normal before operations are resumed. If the Hanford Site Emergency Response Organization

1 was activated and the emergency phase is complete, a special recovery organization could be appointed at
2 the discretion of DOE to restore conditions to normal. This process is detailed in DOE and contractor
3 emergency procedures. The makeup of this organization depends on the extent of the damage and its
4 effects. The onsite recovery organization will be appointed by the appropriate contractor's management.

5 **7.3.5 Incompatible Waste**

6 After an event, the BED or the onsite recovery organization ensures that no waste that might be
7 incompatible with the released material is treated, stored, and/or disposed of until cleanup is completed.
8 Clean up actions are taken by LLBG personnel or other assigned personnel. Permit Attachment 4,
9 *Hanford Emergency Management Plan* (DOE/RL-94-02), Section 9.2.3, describes actions to be taken.

10 Waste from cleanup activities is designated and managed as newly generated waste. A field check for
11 compatibility before storage is preformed, as necessary. Incompatible wastes are not placed in the same
12 container. Containers of waste are placed in approved storage areas appropriate for their compatibility
13 class.

14 If incompatibility of waste was a factor in the incident, the BED or the onsite recovery organization
15 ensures that the cause is corrected.

16 **7.3.6 Post Emergency Equipment Maintenance and Decontamination**

17 All equipment used during an incident is decontaminated (if practicable) or disposed of as spill debris.
18 Decontaminated equipment is checked for proper operation before storage for subsequent use.
19 Consumables and disposed materials are restocked. Fire extinguishers are replaced.

20 The BED ensures that all equipment is cleaned and fit for its intended use before operations are resumed.
21 Depleted stocks of neutralizing and absorbing materials are replenished, protective clothing is cleaned or
22 disposed of and restocked, etc.

23 **7.4 EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT**

24 Hanford Site emergency resources and equipment are described and listed in Permit Attachment 4,
25 *Hanford Emergency Management Plan* (DOE/RL-94-02), Appendix C. Emergency resources and
26 equipment for the LLBG are presented in this section.

Figure 7-1. Burial Grounds, 200 East Area.





Figure 7-2. Burial Grounds, 200 West Area.
