Modification of June 22, 2009 FOIA request.

Dear Ms. Riehle,

Here is a modification of our June 22, 2009 FOIA request. These changes are intended to only modify items 4, 6, 7, and 9 from the previous FOIA request.

Regarding mixed waste disposal trenches 31 and 34, please provide all records relating to:

- a) authorization of construction and operation, including legal bases for authorization to proceed with construction and operation;
- b) analyses of eligibility for construction and operation under RCRA interim status;
- c) all correspondence with regulators regarding construction, operation and permitting;
- d) performance or risk assessments conducted as part of the authorization or permitting processes;
- e) compliance with Washington Administrative Code or RCRA requirements for submitting permit applications or modifications of permit applications or interim status;
- f) inspections of the trenches for RCRA and Washington State Hazardous Waste Management Act compliance;
- g) application of, and compliance, with the Emergency Planning and Community Right to Know Act; and,
- h) identification of waste quantities, waste types and waste sources to be disposed and limits on wastes to be disposed.

Regarding the mixed waste disposal trenches 31 and 34, please provide:

- a) the current RCRA Part A application permit for LLBG Trench 31 and Trench 34;
- b) the current RCRA Part B application permit for LLBG Trench 31 and Trench 34;
- c) the Notice of Intent (NOI) to expand the LLBG and build Trench 31 and Trench 34;

- d) the revised RCRA part A application permit for the LLBG that was submitted prior to the construction of Trench 31 and 34; and
- e) The Notice of Intent (NOI) for any changes of the LLBG with regard to Trench 31 and 34.

Regarding the LLBG located in the 200 West and 200 East areas of Hanford, please provide all records relating to:

- a) the applicability of interim status. This includes the eligibility of the LLBGs to remain under interim status; and
- c) inspection or notices pursuant to RCRA Washington State Hazardous Waste Management Act. This includes any Notice of Intent to expand, change, or alter operations at the LLBG.

Regarding the LLBG located in the 200 West and 200 East areas of Hanford, please provide:

- a) The current RCRA Part A application permit for the LLBG; and
- b) The current RCRA Part B application permit for the LLBG.

The modification should narrow your search and comply with 10 CFR 1004.4(c)(1). Thank you for your assistance.
