FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT REQUEST (FOI 2012-01413)

You requested, pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) "an unexpurgated copy of a document entitled, Standard Inventories of Chemicals and Radionuclides in Hanford Site Tank Wastes," Rev. 0C, HNF-SD-WM-TI-740." You stated that "an expurgated copy of the document can be found at: <http://www5.hanford.gov/pdw/fsd/AR/FSD0001/FSD0053/0911300003/%5B0911300003%5D.PDF>. This version states on the cover page that there are 486 pages to the document, yet only 109 pages are provided. This request seeks a copy of the entire document."

According to our records, Revision 0C that is located on the Internet is a complete copy of that particular revision. For a complete copy of the document, you will need REV-0 (480 pgs), REV-0-A (8 pgs) and REV-0-B (71 pgs). Copies of all the revisions are enclosed.

In addition, you requested a waiver of fees. A determination on your request was not made as costs associated with your request were minimal.

If you consider our response to be a denial to your request, you have the right to appeal to the Office of Hearings and Appeals, as provided in 10 CFR 1004.8, for the adequacy of our search. Any such appeal shall be made in writing to the following address: Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals (HG-1), U.S. Department of Energy, L'Enfant Plaza Building, 1000 Independence Avenue SW, Washington, D.C. 20585-1615, and shall be filed within 30 days after receipt of this letter. Should you choose to appeal, please provide this office with a copy of your letter.
