Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, I request (all evaluations of Contractor Benefit Programs and corrective action plans for Department of Energy Defense Nuclear Facilities required by DOE Order 350.1.)

This request includes the the following requirements of DOE Order 350.1:

- 1) "An evaluation of Contractor Benefit Programs using a professionally recognized measure to compare their benefit programs to other organizations (either a Value Study or a U.S. Chamber of Commerce (COC) Employee Benefit Survey Comparison based on facility size)."
- 2) When the contractor per capita cost per full-time equivalent employee or net benefit value is greater than 5 percent above the comparator for other organizations, the contractor shall submit to the Contracting Officer a corrective action plan to achieve conformance with the range of acceptability defined above, unless otherwise justified in writing. The plan shall include specific benefit plan changes and a timetables for implementation and shall be approved by the Contracting Officer."
