

## Required Forms of Identification for Hanford Site Access

### UNEXPIRED, ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS ONLY

Proper ID is required to access the Hanford Site. Please read the following directions carefully.

**TWO FORMS OF IDENTIFICATION ARE REQUIRED** if your identification is a standard driver's license or state-issued ID card from **Washington**, Missouri, Minnesota, or American Samoa.

NOTE: NAMES ON EACH OF THE TWO DOCUMENTS MUST MATCH

First form of **photo** identification:

- Standard driver's license
- State-issued ID card

Second form of identification:

- U.S. Social Security Card
- Birth Certificate, Original or certified copy with seal, issued by a government entity (state, county, municipality, etc.)
- Hanford Site Specific Badge (Green, Black, Red, or Brown)
- ID card issued by a state or territory of the United States
- ID card issued by a federal, state, or local government agency or entity
- Voter's registration card
- U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card
- Certificate of U.S. Citizenship (Form N-560 or N-561)
- Certificate of Naturalization (Form N-550 or N-570)
- U.S. Citizen ID Card (Form I-197)
- Certification of Birth Abroad (Form FS-545)
- Certification of Report of Birth issued by the Department of State (Form DS-1350)
- Native American tribal document or ID card

**ONLY ONE FORM OF IDENTIFICATION IS REQUIRED** if your identification is one of the following:

- Enhanced driver's license (from any state)
- U.S. Passport or U.S. Passport card
- U.S. Military ID card or U.S. Military Dependent's ID card
- ID card issued by a U.S. government agency
- Personal Identity Verification (PIV) badge
