ATTACHMENT - STATEMENT OF WORK

Third Retrieval Technology for C-105 Waste Retrieval

The following activities shall be completed for the Third Retrieval Technology to retrieve waste from Tank C-105:

- Complete the feasibility study to confirm converting MARS-V to MARS-S is technically viable. (Note: the main area of concern is the support structure and winching mechanism for the new Slurry Pump)
- Complete a cost and schedule analysis to prepare a Baseline Change Request (BCR), ready cost and schedule estimate.
- Complete initial design/installation engineering and work planning. This covers the detail design for the new Slurry Pump support frame, winching mechanism, MARS-S arm installation, control room modifications, and work planning for the associated work scope.
- Complete initial fabrication. Pending the results of the feasibility study and detail design, begin initial fabrication of the needed equipment. This should focus on any long-lead material needs and components requiring additional testing (i.e. winch mechanism and controls).
