A. Purpose of this modification is to:

1. Incorporate the following Orders/Directives:

- DOE Order 110.3A, *Conference Management*
- DOE Order 142.3, *Unclassified Foreign Visits and Assignments Program*
- DOE Order 221.1A, *Reporting Fraud, Waste and Abuse To the Office of Inspector General*
- ORP M 441.1-1, *Nuclear Material Packaging Manual*

2. Incorporate the Integrated Document Management System (IDMS) option as the electronic records management system to be used by the Contractor.

**B. Description of Modification**

1. Incorporate the following Order/Directives:

- DOE Order 110.3A, *Conference Management*  
Implementation of this Order shall have a one time initial cost of \$7,000.00, and annual cost of \$700.00, with a 90-day implementation schedule. Per the Contractor Requirements Document requirements all approvals meeting the requirements of this order must be submitted to the Contracting Officer. Implementation of this Order shall have no other cost or schedule impacts on this contract.
- DOE Order 142.3, *Unclassified Foreign Visits and Assignments Program*  
Implementation of this Order shall have no cost impacts with a 90-day implementation schedule.
- DOE Order 221.1A, *Reporting Fraud, Waste and Abuse To the Office of Inspector General*  
Implementation of this Order shall have no cost impacts with a 90-day implementation schedule.
- ORP M 441.1-1, *Nuclear Material Packaging Manual*  
Implementation of this Order shall have a one time initial cost of \$24,500.00, with a 90-day implementation schedule. Implementation of this Order shall have no other cost or schedule impacts on this contract.

2. Incorporate the Integrated Document Management System (IDMS) as the electronic records management system to be used by ATL. This system is currently the electronic Hanford Site standard and is the most effective and efficient process for long term records management needs. Implementation of this records management system shall have a one-time initial cost not exceed \$209,000.00 and annual cost of \$71,000.00 for FY 2009 and \$42,000.00 thereafter as stated in ATL Letter 08-ATL-033, dated 4/30/2008, with a 90-day implementation schedule.

C. All other terms and conditions of this contract remain the same.
