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**A.0 Solicitation**

**A.1 North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) Code and Size Standard**

(A01) Rev 002 3/1/2011

The Buyer has determined that North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) Code 332992 applies to this acquisition. Therefore, the size standard for determining whether an Offeror is a small business in regard to this acquisition is 1,000 employees or less.

If this solicitation is designated as a small business set-aside, the Offeror certifies that they are a small business by submitting a proposal or an offer to this solicitation.

**A.2 Small Business Set Aside – Solicitation**

(A03) Rev. 1 03/14/2011

Proposals made under this acquisition are solicited from Small Business Concerns, including; Small Disadvantaged, Small Women-Owned, Service Disabled Veteran and HUBZone small businesses. Any resulting Subcontract shall be performed solely by Small Businesses. Proposals received from concerns that are not Small Businesses shall not be considered for award.

Business classifications must comply with Small Business Administration guidelines.

In general:

- Small Women-Owned, Service Disabled-Veteran Owned Business and Small Disadvantaged Business may self-certify their business size.
- Small Disadvantaged Business Qualifications: A small business must be at least 51% owned and controlled by a socially and economically disadvantaged individual or individuals. African Americans, Hispanic Americans, Asian Pacific Americans, Subcontinent Asian Americans, and Native Americans are presumed to qualify. Other individuals can qualify if they show by a [“preponderance of the evidence”](#) that they are disadvantaged. All individuals must have a net worth of less than \$750,000.00,



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excluding the equity of the business and primary residence. Successful applicants must also meet applicable size standards for small businesses in their industry.

The following Small Business Concerns must be certified by the Small Business Administration (SBA):

### **A.3 Award by Aggregate**

Awards shall be made to the low Offeror on all items. If there is no eligible low aggregate Offeror on all items, then the Buyer reserves the right to split the award by item. When in the best interest of the Buyer and awarding by item, the right is further reserved to avoid the administrative costs of multiple awards for closely priced items.

### **A.4 Evaluation of Discount**

Discounts for early payment will be considered in the evaluation of this Offer. The minimum days offered with discount that will be considered are 10.

A separate invoice shall be issued for each delivery. No invoice shall be issued prior to delivery of goods and no payment shall be made prior to receipt of goods.

Discount periods will be computed from the date of receipt of a correct invoice or receipt of merchandise, whichever is later, to the date the Buyer's check is mailed. Discount will be taken on the full amount of the invoice unless freight and other charges are itemized.



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### **A.5 Basis of Award – Lowest Price Technically Acceptable**

#### **C.1 Material Safety Data Sheet Certification**

A Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) is required for any hazardous material required by this document. ### **D.0 Terms and Conditions**

The terms and conditions set forth or referenced in the body of this document by the Buyer shall apply and the Buyer objects to and shall not be bound by any additional or different terms and conditions.

### **D.1 Hazardous Material Rights**

The Subcontractor shall submit a Material Safety Data Sheet, (Department of Labor Form OSHA-174), as prescribed in Federal Standard No. 313D, for all hazardous material in accordance with the delivery schedule requirements set forth within this document. This obligation applies to all materials or items containing hazardous materials. Hazardous material is defined in Federal Standard No. 313D in effect on the date of this Subcontract.

The Subcontractor shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, codes, ordinances and regulations, including the obtaining of licenses and permits), in connection with hazardous material. Neither the requirements of this article, nor any act or failure to act by the Buyer shall relieve the Subcontractor of any responsibility or liability for the safety of the Buyer, Government, Subcontractor or sub-tier Subcontractor personnel or property.

The Buyer shall have the right to use, duplicate and disclose any data to which this clause is applicable. The purpose of this right is to:

1. Apprise personnel of the hazards to which they may be exposed;
2. Obtain medical treatment for those affected by the material; and
3. Have others use, duplicate and disclose the data for Government use in connection with these same purposes.

The Subcontractor shall insert the same clause in any sub-tier Subcontract that may contain hazardous material.

### **D.2 Buy American Act - Non Construction Subcontracts**
