

STATEMENT OF WORK

Title: Purchase one (1) each new trailer by Trail-EZE model TE100TXT.

1.0 Objective/Purpose

The trailer will be used primarily to transport equipment, material and components for ourselves and our customers. This type of trailer is a vital element to the success of the site's accelerated clean-up mission.

2.0 Background/Introduction

The project group within the site complex is in need of this utility trailer to transport equipment and material in supporting the site's clean-up goals.

3.0 Scope, Work, Tasks, Description and Requirements

Purchase 1-each model TE100TXT 50-ton TRI-AXLE, hydraulic operated wren tail trailer with full bed tilt and 10° load angle trailer in accordance with the attached General Specification Sheet.

Delivery date shall be no longer than September 30th, 2010. The Contractor's technical representative shall be available at the time of delivery for approximately one hour, and shall provide assistance during the set-up and operational acceptance testing.
