The Hanford Blog is a new service on [www.hanford.gov](http://www.hanford.gov) that provides general news and information on current activities at the Hanford Site. In the past, information has been provided to the public and media primarily via news releases and briefings in public forums. The Department of Energy and its contractors will post information to the Hanford Blog as it is available from these sources as well as additional content in the future.

The blog is staffed by the Department of Energy's two field offices conducting cleanup at the Hanford Site, the Richland Operations Office and the Office of River Protection. At this time, the blog is designed to be a one-way form of communication and is not staffed to post comments from readers.
