

DOE to forego public FFTF meetings

Michael Holland, who heads the Department of Energy review of the Clinton administration decision to shut down the Fast Flux Test Facility, is holding small meetings with interest groups rather than conducting another round of public meetings. Holland, the manager of DOE's Brookhaven Area Office in New York state, has toured the FFTF.

Holland and his working group met last Friday in Portland with groups opposed to restarting FFTF, and a similar meeting is scheduled for today in Seattle. Tomorrow the team will meet with proponents of an FFTF re-start in Richland. All meetings are by invitation only.
