


## Kent meets the Security Ed Challenge

Congratulations to Virginia Kent of the Department of Energy Richland Operations Office, the winner of the March 17 Security Ed Challenge. Kent won a MiniMag Light for correctly listing the security actions to follow when operating vehicles at Hanford:

- Inspecting the vehicle and the immediate area for suspicious items before entering and driving
- Ensuring vehicles are locked when unattended
- Ensuring vehicles do not contain prohibited articles before driving them to work.

In addition to checking your personal vehicles, Security Ed suggests that all personnel who park government vehicles outside of controlled areas take the extra precaution of inspecting the vehicle's trunk and hidden compartments before entering the Hanford Site. Security Ed says: "Doing an inspection is a good security habit to get into and it relieves you of any extra anxiety when having a vehicle inspected by Hanford Patrol."
