**CY WINDS UP FOR THE PITCH:** Cyril "Cy" Matoske, a clerk in the carpenter shop at the Hanford Engineer Works, was featured on the sports page of the *Sage Sentinel* in the May 15, 1944, issue, when he became manager of the carpenters' team in the Hanford Sunday Baseball League. Matoske lost his right arm when he was two years old, but the accident did not keep him from becoming a baseball player. He pitched in semi-pro and amateur leagues in his home state, Ark., and with the Red River Ordinance Depot in Texarkana, Texas, before managing the Hanford carpenters' team.
