

Web-based ordering of fasteners starts next Monday, July 16

Effective next Monday, July 16, the ordering of certain fasteners will no longer be processed through the BMS PassPort system. The items affected are quality level 0 and 3 fasteners from NOVA Machine Products, which are on the current list of JIT (just in time) contract items. You will be able to order them by using the Nova eStore Web site for Hanford JIT items at <http://oracleerp.nova-nsa.com:8802/html/novarootsection.jsp?minisite=10004>. All current P-Card holders will be registered with the eStore supplier by Monday.

For this commodity, this Friday will be the last day to enter orders in BMS PassPort for delivery the week of July 16. Orders entered after Friday will be redirected to the eStore site.

There are a few restrictions for using the Internet ordering method for chemicals and laboratory and safety supplies. End users must order *only* quality level 0 and 3 items that are on the current JIT contract with NOVA.

If you're a technical support employee who would like to learn more about threaded fasteners, Fluor Hanford Contract Support is sponsoring three all-day sessions of the NOVA-NSA Fastener Training Course in conjunction with the rollout of this new eStore site.

These sessions are intended for procurement engineering, purchasing, design engineering, maintenance and other technical personnel involved with fasteners. Classroom size is limited to 15 students per session and classes will be filled on a first-come-first-served basis. They will be held July 24, 25 and 26 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. at 2430 Stevens, Room 297.
