



## DOE-RL, ORP rolling out first internal Web sites

In the near future, the Department of Energy Richland Operations Office and the Office of River Protection will “roll out” their first internal Web sites — also referred to as DOE Intranet sites.

The new sites will be colorful, informative and user-friendly. They will offer a wide variety of subjects and material for DOE employees including news, event calendars, training information, internal documents, human resources information and much more.

Currently, DOE employees access individual internal pages via links to particular Web addresses. Although this works, it is often time-consuming — and, unless the page is “bookmarked” it is very difficult to find the same Web page again.

According to Guy Schein, DOE-RL Web manager, “This will be an extremely useful resource for DOE employees. The Intranet will provide many tools to help employees do their jobs more efficiently.”

Earlier this year, a Lockheed Martin Services team designed a new look for Hanford’s home page. This same team has designed the new Intranet sites for DOE-RL and ORP. “We are looking forward to having this internal capability available for our employees,” said Erik Olds of the ORP Office of Communications.

The DOE-RL and ORP Intranet sites, along with the Hanford Intranet, will enable Hanford employees to gain access to information in essentially all areas of business. ♦
