**PROGRESS IN RIVER CORRIDOR:** Last month, the Environmental Restoration Contractor team, led by Bechtel Hanford, demolished D Reactor exhaust and storage rooms in the 100D Area. The rubble and contaminated material were removed and safely deposited in the Environmental Restoration Disposal Facility, or ERDF. D Reactor is one of eight reactors to be placed into interim safe storage, a process known as “cocooning,” for up to 75 years. The process of cocooning D Reactor is 47 percent complete.
