

# ORP names Taylor and Schwier to management positions

Department of Energy Office of River Protection Manager Harry Boston recently announced the selection of William Taylor as ORP assistant manager for Project Delivery and Jeanie Schwier as the assistant manager for Integration and Control.

As assistant manager for Project Delivery, Taylor has management responsibilities for all ORP projects performed by CH2M HILL Hanford Group, Inc. and Bechtel National, Inc. Bechtel will design, build and commission the Waste Treatment Plant at Hanford, and CH2M HILL Hanford Group is responsible for retrieving the Hanford tank waste, delivering it to the Waste Treatment Plant and disposing of or storing the treated waste.

Taylor has been the acting assistant manager for Project Delivery at ORP since August 2000. Prior to that, he had served as DOE director of the Waste Disposal Division of the Tank Waste Remediation System since 1995. He was employed with the Raytheon Corporation for 27 years and has experience in commercial reactor operations, project management and business development.

As ORP's assistant manager for Integration and Control, Schwier is responsible for integrating a wide range of complex activities to assure that the work conducted by Bechtel National and CH2M HILL Hanford Group is properly aligned, including integrated project baseline and risk management.

Prior to accepting the position with ORP, Schwier was the director of the Office of Financial Services and chief financial officer at the DOE's Richland Operations Office. Schwier has 27 years of federal government experience in budget planning, contractor oversight, performance measurement and strategic planning.
