

United Way Hanford Pacesetters campaigning



The United Way Pacesetter campaign is well under way at Hanford. This year's Hanford drive is co-chaired by Dave Van Leuven, executive vice president of Fluor Hanford, and Tom Schaffer, president of the Hanford Atomic Metal Trades Council. Mike Hughes, president of Bechtel Hanford, directs the area-wide Vintner Campaign, and Ed Aromi, executive vice president of CH2M HILL Hanford Group, is a co-chair for the area-wide campaign.

The Hanford workforce typically donates about half of all the money raised by the United Way of Benton and Franklin Counties.

There are important company gift-matching programs available to Fluor Hanford and CHG employees. The Fluor Foundation matches employee contributions at 50 cents on the dollar, and CH2M HILL matches 25 cents for every employee dollar.

For the area-wide campaign, all new contributions (those given above last year's donation) that are pledged by Oct. 1 and collected by March 31 will also be matched dollar for dollar by Williams Gas Pipeline. ♦
