

WATER TOWER CUT-UP: Welder Jimmy Rogers of Fluor Hanford uses a cutting torch in taking apart the 3902A water tower in the 300 Area. DynCorp Tri-Cities Services Crane and Rigging then lowered the top of the tower to the ground. Cut-up pieces of the water tower were loaded on flatbed trucks that were driven to the burial grounds in 200 West. The intent had been to reuse the steel from both this and the 3902B water tower, but small amounts of uranium contamination found between layers of paint made the towers only suitable for permanent disposal.
