(3.1.1)

It is a Washington River Protection Solutions LLC (WRPS) policy that employees may voluntarily, and at their own risk, participate in the following allowed recreational activities when on the Hanford site during scheduled lunch breaks or before and after work hours: walking, jogging/running, basketball, and volleyball, and company provided fitness/exercise equipment. This policy implements that Hanford Site Recreational Policy as required by Contract.

2.0 IMPLEMENTATION

The following guidelines apply at all times when participating in an approved recreational activity on the Hanford site:

- Participants should understand their personal limitations prior to participation and properly prepare for the activity for which they are about to engage.
- Recreational bicycle riding and other roller sport activities are not permitted. Bicycles used for commuting south of the Wye barricade or for performance of assigned duties are allowed on contractor approved routes.
- Allowed recreational activities and equipment are limited to those approved by Safety and Health, within designated areas during daylight hours for outdoor activities and in accordance with company policies (see Attachment A).

Facility and Property Manager inspects and maintains existing fitness equipment only (e.g., Recumbent Bike, Elliptical, Upright Bike, and Multi-Station Gym) via a maintenance contract with vendor. Funding is not provided for new equipment or for recreational activities.

- Inspections of recreational activity areas and equipment shall be part of the scheduled EAPC inspections. Any maintenance issues with approved recreational activity areas and equipment shall be communicated through the EAPC and presented to upper management for funding.
- Recreational activities on Gable Mountain, Gable Butte, or Rattlesnake Mountain are not permitted (including on designated roadways).
- Recreational activities are only permitted in areas designated by facility management; (see Attachment B)
- All activities shall be conducted in compliance with applicable laws, regulations and postings. Appropriate safety equipment shall be used while participating in allowed recreational activities.
- Participants shall notify their management when participating in a recreational activity away from their immediate work area.

- Fitness equipment shall be used in accordance with posted manufacturer instructions. Participants who are unsure of equipment operation should contact the Safety and Health Department for a demonstration.
- Participants shall inspect all fitness equipment and areas prior to use; defective equipment and noted safety hazards shall be corrected prior to use.
- Notify the Building Administrator when defective fitness equipment is identified. Defective fitness equipment should be posted out of service until fixed or removed from the area.
- Prior to using equipment employees must read and sign the regulation document posted in each exercise area.
- The use of exercise balls as an office or guest chair is prohibited.




