

Offeror Questions/WRPS Answers/WRPS Comments

- Is there a technical representative at this time? I notice in the subcontract example that this information is TBD. Or, will that information only be generated when the contract is awarded?
 - The WRPS technical representative will be named in the subcontract at the time of award. The awarded Subcontract will use the format shown in the example (Model Subcontract) and all noted "TBD" will be specified at the time of award.
- A question was asked regarding taking exceptions to Master Submittal Register (MSR) submittal schedule timeframe requirements (e.g.: 45 days from award).
 - Offered exceptions may deem an Offeror's proposal as non-responsive should others provide offers that are fully compliant with the Solicitation.
- Will there be milestones (payments) set in the schedule that will allow for partial invoicing as the project progresses?
 - For solicitation purposes, provide fixed price to complete each task as requested in the Solicitation. Milestones, if warranted, may be discussed prior to award, however, this is a short-term project to complete by 9/30/15, so offerors should have the financial capability to finance each task through completion.

No technical discussions with WRPS personnel are to occur during the Solicitation process.
