# Mission

The Waste Program Division (WPD) provided Management for programmatic Hanford activities related to radioactive solid waste, containerized dangerous waste, liquid effluents, analytical services, transportation and packaging, and pollution prevention.

Activities included: storage, treatment, and disposal of radioactive, mixed, transuranic, and hazardous wastes; treatment and disposal of radioactive, mixed, transuranic, and hazardous wastes; treatment and disposal of liquid effluents; all activities including sampling, data management, analytical, and process development for Hanford analytical services requirements; offsite and onsite traffic manager activities, including packaging design and construction; and Hanford pollution prevention.

## **Mission (cont.)**

WPD provided oversight, coordination and technical evaluation of the offsite waste streams from the Oakland, Chicago, and Oak Ridge Operations Offices, the Rocky Flats Field Office, and Naval Reactors programs. WPD also had programmatic responsibility for the facilities wherein assigned programs are carried out. In this role, coordination with the Office of Waste Management (HQ) assured operations are conducted in a safe and environmentally sound manner that is in compliance with applicable regulations and standards.
