# FY 2000 Planned Activities

- Complete audit and certification by CAO/EPA/NMED; initiate waste shipment to WIPP, and complete 6 shipments
- Continue TRU retrieval, with a minimum of 400 drums scheduled (600 stretch)
- 37,400 ft<sup>3</sup> of MLLW are scheduled for non-thermal treatment at ATG
- Complete design requirements document to support transfer of K Basin sludge to T Plant
- 244,900 ft<sup>3</sup> and 63,400 ft<sup>3</sup> of LLW and MLLW are projected for disposal
- Continue wastewater treatment and disposal at 200 ETF, 242A, 200 TEDF and 300 TEDF
- Continue to support Site cleanup with quality analytical services
