Key Positives: Washington River Protection Solutions, LLC (WRPS) exceeded many of the significant award fee criteria and has met overall cost, schedule, and technical performance requirements of the contract in the aggregate, as defined and measured against criteria in the award-fee plan for the evaluation period. The successful restart of the 242-A Evaporator for the first time in four years was a noteworthy achievement. WRPS exhibited consistent leadership in achieving Voluntary Protection Program Star Status, improving One System alignment and resolution of the deep sludge gas release phenomenon.

Key Areas for Improvement: WRPS' achievements were countered by challenges with retrieval equipment failures and mitigating actions to address vapor impacts within the Tank Farms.
