SUBJECT: Hanford to Remain in Phase 2 Operations

The Hanford Site is anticipated to remain in Phase 2 operations for an extended duration. During this time, we will continue the measured and deliberate approach to remobilization, increasing the work scope and the associated additional workforce to meet the needs of the Site. While the rate of local new COVID-19 cases continues to decrease, our collective commitment to COVID-19 protocols remains a critical element in preventing a resurgence. The COVID-19 protocols that have proven effective in our earlier phases remain in effect throughout Phase 2. Site leadership remains engaged with area officials each week, monitoring local conditions, to continue making appropriate decisions for the Site in support of the health of the Hanford team and our community.

Given our expectation that the Site will remain in Phase 2 for an extended period, DOE will discontinue sending weekly sitewide posture messages and ask employers to provide information directly to their workforce regarding work activities and personnel assignments. Should conditions change, we will respond accordingly with appropriate communications. The Hanford Mobile app also continues to provide notifications on Site conditions and facility access restrictions.

Please remember the lessons we have learned over the past few months: maintain social distancing, wear face coverings, wash your hands often, and stay home if you are ill. As summer gives way to fall and we soon enter the holiday season, people will begin spending more time indoors. Focusing on the

measures that have proven effective in controlling the spread of COVID-19 has never been more important to our team and our community. I remain confident that, working together, we will move forward towards a prosperous future, continuing to provide safe, efficient and effective cleanup of the Hanford Site.
