The Hanford Site remains in Phase 2 of its COVID-19 remobilization plan. More employees are returning to their regular duty stations, which means that our established COVID-19 protocols of wearing face coverings, practicing social distancing, frequent hand-washing, performing daily health self-assessments before work, and staying home if ill remain as important as ever. It is also critical that, if you are contacted by contact tracers, either with HPMC Occupational Medical Services or the health district, you accurately respond to their questions. We all have a responsibility to protect our teammates and our families.

While cases of COVID-19 in our area have reached a low plateau, the disease is not yet eradicated. With the approaching fall season and cooler temperatures, people will be staying indoors more, potentially increasing the possibility of exposure. Additionally, seasonal flu typically arrives in our community this time of year. The same protocols we have used effectively to combat COVID-19 are also helpful to protect you, your teammates, your friends, and your family members from catching the seasonal flu, and getting a flu shot this fall is highly encouraged.

Moving forward, as we expect to remain in Phase 2 of the Hanford remobilization for the foreseeable future, I will send these messages less frequently, unless conditions on the Site or in the community change. Thank you for your continued commitment to our important work and please stay safe and healthy.
