**SUBJECT: Expanded Vaccine Eligibility for Washington Residents Age 16 and Older**

On April 15, all Washington residents age 16 and older will become eligible for the COVID-19 vaccines. HPMC Occupational Medical Services has received the Moderna vaccine, and will vaccinate Hanford workers in accordance with this revised statewide eligibility.

Hanford workers are encouraged to get vaccinated against COVID-19. You can use the Hanford [Vaccine Scheduling Tool](#) to make a Moderna vaccination appointment at HPMC. The vaccinations will be provided by HPMC registered nurses at the main clinic located at 1979 Snyder Street. Appointments are estimated to last 20 minutes, including the mandatory post-injection observation period, and you will be automatically scheduled for the second dose. Note that HPMC **cannot** provide the vaccine to anyone who has ever experienced a severe allergic reaction that required epinephrine, or who may be pregnant, about to become pregnant or is currently breast-feeding.
