As a reminder, HPMC Occupational Medical Services will perform contact tracing for Hanford personnel when there is more than one COVID-19 case identified at a work building within a 14-day period. HPMC OMS provides contact tracing services for the DOE Richland Operations Office, DOE Office of River Protection, and the following contractors and their subcontractors: Hanford Mission Integration Solutions, Central Plateau Cleanup Company, Washington River Protection Solutions, Hanford Laboratory Management and Integration, Bechtel National Inc., and HPMC OMS.

If you have COVID-19, it is recommended you notify those you have been in close contact with right away so they can follow CDC [recommendations](#) to quarantine, get tested, and wear a well-fitting mask, depending on their vaccination and booster status or history of prior infection.

Do not go to places where you are unable to wear a mask, such as restaurants and some gyms, and avoid eating around others at home and at work until 10 days after your last close contact with someone with COVID-19.
