For the week of **August 6–12**, 2022, the Community Level in Benton and Franklin counties has returned to medium. Based on this status, **masks are no longer required** indoors and are **optional** at all Hanford Site facilities, regardless of vaccination status. **Masks are still required for anyone visiting HPMC OMS or other healthcare facilities.**
