


A ~~Simple~~ Guide to the Hanford Budget Process

US DOE Richland Operations and US DOE Office of River Protection Offices submit separate budget requests to fund all work required for compliance with the Tri-Party Agreement.


US DOE Headquarters receives the RL and ORP Budget Requests, combines them with the other US DOE Environmental Management (EM) budget requests, and then gives them to the White House Office of Management and Budget (OMB).

OMB reviews budgets



The President presents the Federal Budget Proposal for the next Federal Fiscal Year to Congress.

Congress reviews budget proposal and may:



*For example, Congress could approve new spending rates from a previous year such as 2008 spending levels.
