



1943-1964: 149 single-shell tanks constructed

- ✓ 67 assumed to have leaked
- ✓ Estimated that over 1 million gallons has leaked

1968-1986: 28 double-shell tanks constructed

- ✓ 1 leaking, waste contained within annulus

Disposition of **56** million gallons of radioactive and chemical waste





-  Single-Shell Tank Farm

- ▶ **28 DOUBLE-SHELL TANKS**






