

## DOE Regulatory/Contractual Drivers for Training

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*10 CFR 830, Subpart A, "Quality Assurance Requirements," and DOE Order 414.1, 'Quality Assurance,'* contain general requirements for initial training of personnel. These requirements assure workers are capable of performing their assigned work and that they maintain their job proficiency through continuing training.

*DOE Order 426.2, "Personnel Selection, Training, Qualification, and Certification Requirements for DOE Nuclear Facilities,"* contains requirements for contractor personnel who can impact the safety basis through their involvement in the operation, maintenance, and technical support of DOE nuclear facilities. This order:

- Is incorporated into the CH2M HILL Plateau Remediation Company and Washington Closure Hanford contracts
- Is not included in the Mission Support Alliance (MSA) contract, because MSA is not responsible for nuclear facilities. However, the MSA contract includes clause C.2.1.2 which states *"The Site Training program provides training facilities, curriculum, and training delivery services to the Federal, contractor, and sub-contractor employees in support of the Hanford and PNNL missions consistent with the DOE, local, State, and Federal workforce training requirements."*
