

Waste Treatment Plant Progress and Communications Approach (Joint w/PIC)

- Distinct from general public, should have local community audience
 - Pam will propose language
- Add media/press to “Audiences”
- Reword second part of first bullet in consent decree
 - Segment information for public
- Excuse for not sharing info – revise
- Bullets under consent decree – ideas expressed by individuals
- Consent decree: sounds too final, 30-day window
- Distinguish: information should be released, but structured (e.g. comment periods)
- Next steps:
 - TWC final comments due to Issue Managers by 3/25/16
 - Provide to Board in advance, early April
 - PIC will review newest draft at PIC meeting on 4/12/16
 - PIC will incorporate edits and distribute to Board during April Board meeting
 - Short discussion will take place at April Board meeting
 - TWC will revise in April and May
 - Final white paper will be presented during June Board meeting

Cesium/LAWPS

- In conclusion or cover letter, possibly describe “in a perfect world” scenario and preferred option that does not return cesium to DSTs
 - Focus on HLW online
 - Deep geologic repository
 - Other policy changes
- Don’t expect consensus on options
- In conclusion, describe summary of perspectives on preferences, range of opinions
- Next steps
 - Issue managers to summarize points in conclusion
 - TWC will review
 - Cover letter
 - Opinion on deep geologic repository
 - Opinion on double-shell tanks
 - Convey options to Board – possibly in April
 - DOE-ORP will provide comments
