74%	Useful agency presentations at meetings
70%	Useful agency responses at meetings

RESPONDENTS' BOARD MEETING ATTENDANCE

- Range of attendance for Board meetings = 67 – 92%
- December 2013 was least attended meeting
- November 2014 was the most attended meeting
