BCC Update

- Since the summer 2018 our BCC committee membership has grown from 8 to 12 members!



- Responded to DOE on initial CPCC Draft RFP with comments on Oct 24, 2018.
- BCC meeting was held on Nov 8, 2018.
- BCC coordinated the FY2021 Budget Priorities Advice activities as a cross-cutting HAB activity, and approved the final Draft version for the April 17 HAB meeting.

BCC Update (Cont)

- In early December, 2018, due to DOE comments received from HAB/Bidders/Other Stakeholders, DOE revised their End States Contracting Model (ESCM) for Procurements.
- On Jan 28, 2019 the BCC completed review and submitted comments to DOE on two separate Hanford Prime Contract Draft Procurement actions:
 - CPCC Revised Draft RFP (issued Jan 17).
 - TCC Draft RFP (issued Jan 18).
- Recent DOE Procurement actions:
 - DOE awarded the Occ Med contract on Dec 31, 2018 to HPM Corp (the current provider of these services)
 - DOE issued final RFPs for the CPCC and TCC in March, 2019

BCC Update (Cont)

- Upcoming Near-Term BCC Activities:
 - Review/comment on Draft RFP for 222-S Lab (once issued)
 - Evaluation of DOE Response to FY2021 Budget Priorities Advice (once recd)
 - Promote (via Co-Hosting/Supporting) DOE presentations (**subject to BCC Discussion/Agreement**):
 - Long-term viability of Hanford Cleanup plan in view of recent reports:
 - Corps of Engr Parametric Evaluation of Hanford Tank Wastes
 - DOE Lifecycle Scope, Schedule, Cost Report (issued Jan 2019)
 - GAO report on DOE Site Cleanup Liability
 - NAS activities re: Hanford Tank Waste processing
 - DOE 10-year Hanford Plan (to be generated for HQ)

BCC Update (Cont)

- (Continued) Promote (via Co-Hosting/Supporting) DOE presentations **(subject to BCC Discussion/Agreement)**:
 - Integrated Tank Waste Project Plan addressing:
 - WIR
 - Test Bed Initiative
 - High Level Tank Waste Reclassification
 - DFLAW
 - WTP
 - Risk-based DOE Hanford Cleanup Decision Process
 - Site Maintenance Activity Plan and Potential Cost Improvements (min safe/Infrastructure/essential services)
 - End States Contracting Model -- bases , benefits, shortcomings, and working examples
