# BCC Update

- BCC call held on May 28
  - Highlighted announcements of upcoming HAB events
  - Discussed/assessed BCC interests in 15 potential HAB-identified COTW topics
- EM-1 (Anne White) resigned end of May:
  - BCC interested in possible impacts to Hanford prime contractor End-State contract awards, Hanford budget support.

# BCC Update (Cont)

- GAO Report (issued March 2019) on DOE High Risk areas was reviewed
  - Two areas affecting DOE-EM were identified:
    - Need for improved Proj Mgmt (including risk assessments), and
    - Concern with increasing DOE environmental liabilities.

# BCC Update(Cont)

- Current plans for DOE Prime Contract awards:
  - Three Hanford 10-year awards expected by the end of August, and a fourth award expected three months later.
    - Hanford Mission Essential Services (HMES)
    - Hanford Tank Closure Contract (TCC)
    - Hanford Central Plateau Cleanup Contract (CPCC)
    - Hanford 222-S Laboratory Management

# BCC Update (Cont)

- U.S. House Appropriations Committee approved legislation to increase Hanford FY2020 funding to \$2.4 B
  - Still ~\$37M below FY2019 levels
  - Includes \$10 million for the next phase of Hanford's Test Bed Initiative to process 2000 gal of Low Activity Waste (could lead to treatment of 90% of tank wastes)
  - Top focus continues to be DFLAW by FY2023
