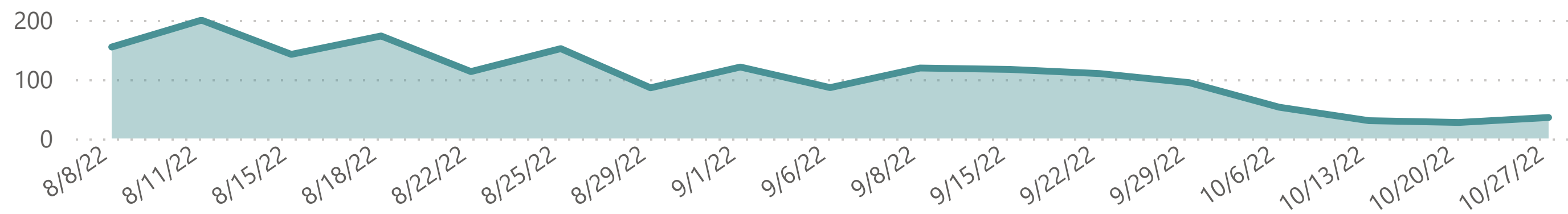

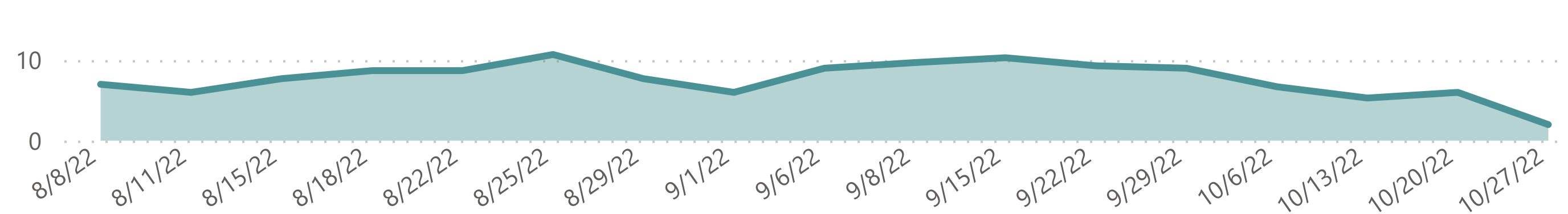

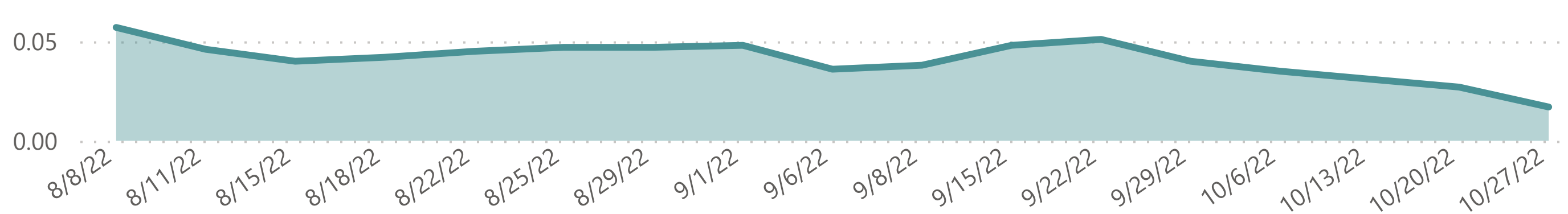
Cases per 100k by Date



Admissions per 100k by Date

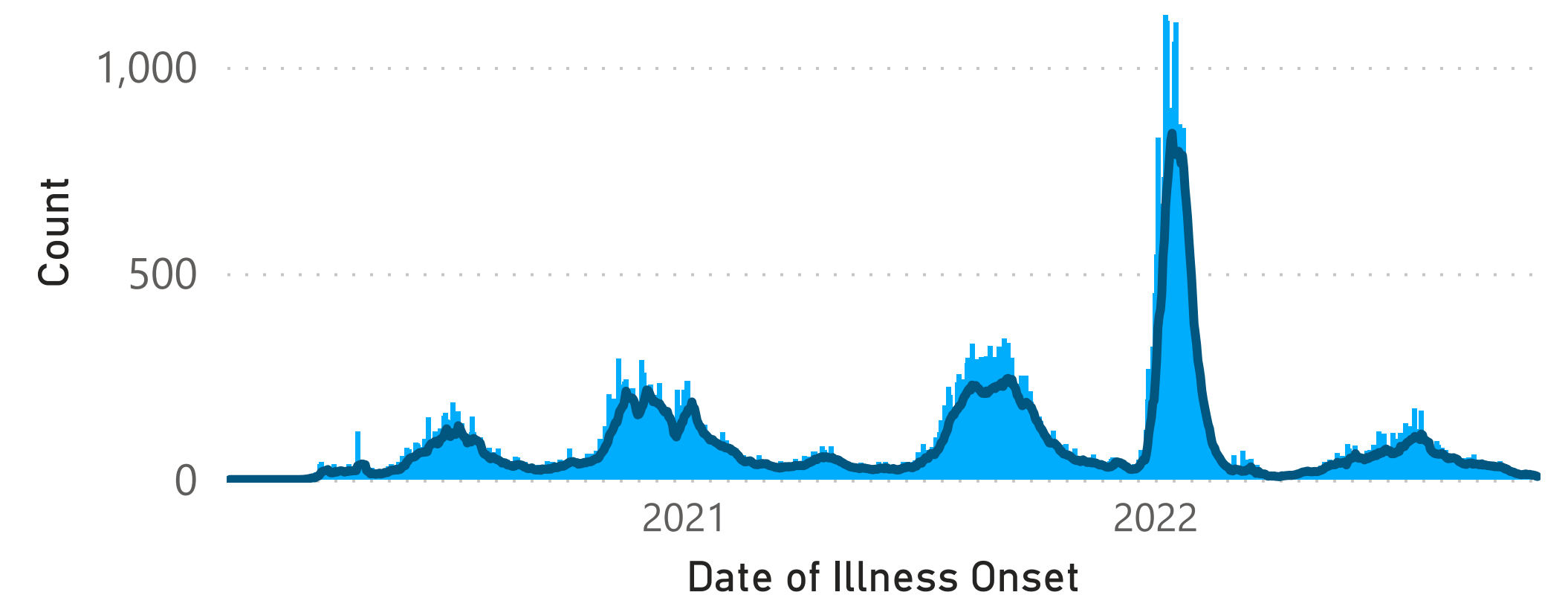


% Staffed inpatient beds by Date
