In accordance with Contract Clauses B.2, Obligation and Availability of Funds, and I.57, FAR 52.232-22, Limitation of Funds (Apr 1984), the purpose of this modification is to decrease the amount of funding for the following Inter-Entity Work Orders (IWO): (1) IWO No. 191627, Mod. 4 - funding is hereby decreased by (\$14,405.20); and (2) IWO No. 202176, Mod. 3 - funding is hereby decreased by (\$7,766.12). Total obligated base funding is hereby decreased by (\$22,171.32), from \$2,257,681,688.56 to \$2,257,659,517.24. Contract revisions are detailed on Page 2 of this modification.

- B. This modification hereby deobligates base funding in the amount of (\$22,171.32) for FY 2014 as detailed below and in the “Financial Plan Report – Detail” (Financial Plan No. 2014-16), attached as Page 4 of this modification.
1. Funding in the amount of (\$14,405.20) is hereby deobligated from the contract for IWO No. 191627, Mod. 4, under Program No. 1721310 with the Pacific Northwest National Laboratory (PNNL). A copy of IWO No. 191627, Mod. 4, and the associated “Certification of Funds Available for Withdrawal” document are included as Pages 5 and 6 of this modification.
 2. Funding in the amount of (\$7,766.12) is hereby deobligated from the contract for IWO No. 202176, Mod. 3, under Program No. 1721310 with PNNL. A copy of IWO No. 202176, Mod. 3, and the associated “Certification of Funds Available for Withdrawal” document are attached as Pages 7 and 8 of this modification.
- C. Contract Section B, paragraph B.2(a), is modified to reflect a decrease of (\$22,171.32) in obligated base funding, from \$2,257,681,688.56 to \$2,257,659,517.24. Contract Section B.2(a) has been changed as detailed below. Contract Replacement Page B-2 is attached to this modification.

- (b) Pursuant to the clause in Section I, entitled "Limitation of Funds," total funds in the amount of \$233,588,557.29 are obligated herein and made available for payment of allowable costs and fee earned related only to the Recovery Act work from the effective date of Modification A099 through the period of performance for the Recovery Act work, contained in Section F.
- (c) Except as may be specifically provided in the Section I clause entitled *Nuclear Hazards Indemnity Agreement*, the duties and obligations of the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) hereunder calling for the expenditure of appropriated funds shall be subject to the availability of funds appropriated by the U.S. Congress that DOE may legally spend for such purposes.

B.3 ALLOWABILITY OF SUBCONTRACTOR FEE


