SUBJECT: **Hanford Site to Remain in Phase 1 Operations Next Week**

During the week of 20 July, the Hanford Site operational posture will remain in Phase 1 operations, with a small increase in the number of onsite workers to support planned activities.

Site leadership will continue to evaluate local and state data and trends to determine our Site posture for the following week as we continue in this phase, taking into consideration testing availability, case trends, and hospital availability. Of note, HPMC Occupational Medical Services has commenced contact tracing for Hanford workers who have tested positive for COVID-19 to assist our community health care team.

We will continue our engagement with local community leaders and health officials, and our focus remains on your health and safety as we continue to advance our important cleanup work. We are also continuing to follow established COVID-19 safety protocols, including social distancing, using face coverings, increased hand washing, and conducting pre-work checklists to assess our own health.

As we continue to experience and enjoy the great Tri-Cities summer weather, please don't forget to maintain established COVID-19 health and safety protocols if you go out into the community. Your commitment to these protocols and practices helps keep the Hanford workforce, your family and our local community healthy. Monitor your health daily and stay at home or seek medical attention if you are not feeling well.
