TPA M-91 TRUM

- M-91 Negotiations
 - We had hoped to start public comment July 2019
 - DOE and Ecology did not reach agreement (DOE would not commit to start shipping date)
 - DOE shipping dates proposal due 9/30/2020
 - Public comment would follow
- USDOE continues to meet schedules (M-91-52-T01) for repacking TRUM waste boxes stored outside of its Central Waste Complex



Holistic negotiations

- Ecology Director Maia Bellon proposed holistic negotiation of tank waste retrieval, treatment: May 29
 - Parties met numerous times and this week agreed to scope
 - Parties agree on a Department of Justice mediator to help us
- ORP notified Ecology of "serious risk" to Consent Decree milestones: Sept. 4
 - Ecology is still waiting for a response to our letters of September 25, 2019 and October 25, 2019 letters requesting a Consent Decreerequired written recitation of the factors that led to DOE's "serious risk" notification

Closure plans for T-Plant and CWC

- Ecology is issuing a draft permit modification to close seven container storage areas at T Plant and Central Waste Complex.
- 6 of the 7 closing units were identified by EPA's June 2016 Consent Agreement and Final Order (Docket No.: RCRA-10-2013-0113).
- Waste has not been stored in these areas since November 2010.
- Future waste storage is not authorized.
- Public comment period runs from December 16, 2019, through February 7, 2020.
