- Observe surroundings during entry and exit of the Site, including barricades and buildings.
- Observe surroundings constantly while working on the Hanford Site, in all locations.
- Visually observe personnel to confirm appropriate badges that indicate access are allowed.
- Observe areas that may be vulnerable to trespassing and unauthorized access to the site.

To promote this effort, Trespassing Awareness posters are being added in Site buildings with more than five people.
