## Mission:

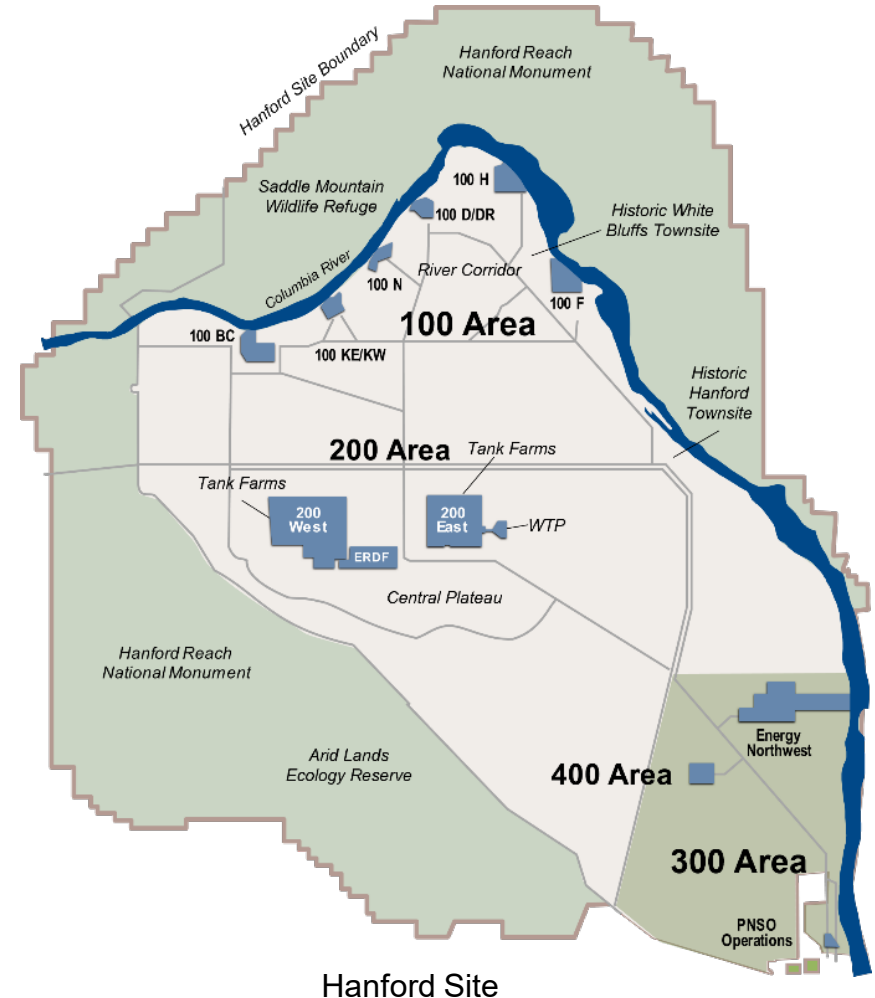
Safely and effectively treating tank waste and delivering environmental remediation

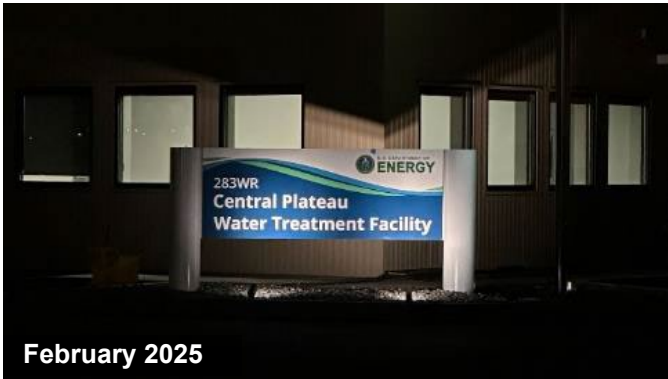
